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# FACING FEAR WITH PERSEVERANCE

One of the *greatest qualities* of a *leader* is the *ability to inspire* their team to *persevere* through fear and change. Leaders look ahead and anticipate challenges that their teams will face. However, even when things do not go according to plan, leaders find a way to help others stand strong amidst the uncertainty.

Take Sir Ernest Shackleton for example. His is one of the greatest stories of perseverance. Shackleton's passion was exploration. Specifically, he was in love with discovering the South Pole. His first two expeditions to Antarctica set records, despite having to turn back each time. When his competitor Roald Amundsen was the first to reach the South Pole in 1911, Shackleton turned to an even greater goal: crossing the Antarctic continent altogether.

In December of 1914, Shackleton and his team of 27 men set off for Antarctica on the ship Endurance.

The ship slowly made its way through the polar waters when weather conditions caused the ship to get trapped in place by surrounding ice. During this time, Shackleton reportedly did everything he could to keep spirits up among the crew. After nine months aboard the stopped ship, it became evident that the Endurance was sinking. But that didn't stop Shackleton's endurance. He ordered his men to abandon the vessel and camp on the ice. For months he used the ice currents to drift back toward

land. When the ice floe on which the team was encamped broke in two, they evacuated into three remaining lifeboats. The exhausted men eventually landed on the uninhabited Elephant Island – the first time they had stood on solid ground for 497 days. Shackleton could see that rescue from such a remote island was improbable, and so he took five men to seek a rescue party at the nearest whaling station. Shackleton endured for four more months and three failed attempts until all the remaining crew members were saved in August of 1916. Despite all of the challenges, Shackleton returned with every single member of his crew.

Thankfully, we all do not face the fear and uncertainty of Ernest Shackleton in our everyday life. However, we can adopt his spirit. Successful entrepreneurs such as Daymond John, founder of FUBU and Beto Perez, founder of Zumba Fitness embodied this determined spirit and built multimillion dollar companies that we all know today. Leaders like these choose to *focus on the possibilities of change rather than the fear of it.* When it seems we are metaphorically stuck, sinking or even breaking in two, Ernest Shackleton's story is an inspiration to persevere and endure. - 1 tbsp vanilla

- 1. Combine water, brown sugar and cinnamon in a small saucepan over medium-high heat.
- Whisk until sugar dissolves, then reduce heat and simmer until mixture is reduced by half (about 5 minutes). Add vanilla to reduced syrup.
- 3. Allow to cool for at least 1 hour.
- 4. Set aside for now or seal and save for later!


#### **CINNAMON DOLCE ICED LATTE**
